

Data Protection Act 2018 Consent Form

The Data Protection Act 1998 has been replaced by the Data Protection Act 2018 from 25 May 2018. This means that the Nottinghamshire Chess Association (NCA) needs your consent to hold and process your personal data. The NCA Policy states which data will be used and what for. A copy should be shown to you when signing this form.

Everyone who plays in the League or for a County Team needs to give their prior consent to use of their name, club, results and ECF grading and membership details in accordance with the policy. These are used for:

- Recording match results
- Checking eligibility
- Grading of games
- Charging fees for non-ECF members

To be invited to play for a County Team, contact details (phone and/or email) will also be required.

Everyone who wishes to act as a club team captain or as any NCA officer must also give their consent to the use of further information, such as phone numbers and email addresses, in accordance with the policy.
