#### **NOTES FOR COMPETITORS**

- See eligibility criteria before entering, or contact the organisers if unsure
- ECF rapidplay-rated event.
- Maximum permitted entries: 100.
- Prize money will be shared in the event of a tie, no player can win more than one prize, which will be the largest eligible prize.
- Sections may be merged and prizes redistributed if numbers are low.
- The default time will be 15 minutes after the start of the round.
- Pairings will be made using Swiss Manager, pairings and results will be published on chess-results.com before the start of each round.
- The November 2022 ECF OTB rating list has precedence over all other lists for allocating players to sections. Rapidplay rating (a min of 6 games) takes precedence over standard when players have both. Unrated players must provide information about their playing ability, including previous results and any rating previously held. Unrated players cannot win rating prizes.
- Free car parking on site and nearby. Smoking not permitted anywhere on site.
- Players shall adhere to covid regulations in force at the time of the event, and
  any restrictions required by the venue. Players participate at their own risk.
   Hygiene measures will be put in place by the organisers: please check the
  website during November for any changes.
- Free hot and cold drinks will be available on site, players are encouraged to bring their own food. No hot food may be brought into the venue.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Entry is restricted to players meeting at least one of the following criteria:

- 1. Born in Nottinghamshire
- 2. Living in Nottinghamshire
- 3. Working in Nottinghamshire
- 4. Attending an educational establishment in Nottinghamshire
- Member of a club based in Nottinghamshire or affiliated to Nottinghamshire Chess Association
- 6. Previously meeting one of the criteria 2-5 above
