Although Notts. vs. Leics. matches are always close, this is the first time I can remember the result actually being a draw. On paper the teams were very evenly matched, but for most of the match a Notts. loss appeared likely. However Chris Dunworth managed to win a good rook ending after being in bad time trouble, and Graham Waddingham's opponent threw away a level position, losing a piece for two pawns. By adjudication time Graham had won one pawn back and, although the game was sent off, the result was never in doubt. One worrying feature of the match was the continuing poor form of several of the lower boards. Although the higher boards continue to perform well, all the team will have to play well if Notts. are to progress beyond the East Midlands zone.

The fate of the East Midlands zone now rests on the match versus Derbyshire on March 3rd. If we win or draw we shall go through to the MCCU semi-finals, a loss would be the end of this year's county first team matches.

Finally two games from the match, the first Mark Cooke's in which his opponent, after achieving equality by move 15, appears to compromise his position in an attempt to attack, and falls victim to a swift counter-attack. The second is Glen Halfpenny's in which a long-term piece sacrifice is necessary to open up a blocked position. Although the sacrifice may not be sound it is quite sufficient for his opponent.

BEWARE THE GLAZIER ROOK

Immortality came early in life to Lawrence Glazier. Playing in the Northern Counties junior championship in 1972, Lawrence, the holder, lost a game rather dismally but, true to form, collected several of us together to demonstrate the manner of his demise. Building up a strong attack against his opponent's castled king Lawrence had tried to reinforce his initiative with the manoeuvre R-K1-K3-KR3. Unfortunately, in his impatience to deliver checkmate he had forgotten the old but valid maxim - "an attack on the wing is best met by a counter in the centre". When the counter came Lawrence's central control was seen to be minimal, his king-side initiative evaporated and the collapse was hastened dramatically by his inability to re-centralise the formally aggressive rook. So impressed were the on-lookers that they agreed spontaneously that such a misguided rook should forever be named in memory of our illustrious (by now) ex-champion.

Several years later the American grandmaster Walter Browne tried to steal the immortality for himself at the cost of losing to Paul Keres. But whoever heard of a "Browne Rook"? I give the latter game below:
