After last year's unsuccessful experiment in holding the Congress in May we have reverted back to April in an attempt to increase our entries. There are the usual 4 sections and entries permitting, with grading prizes especially in the Major, Intermediate and Minor Tournaments the prize fund will reach £2000!

At the present time we intend to invite 2 IGM's, and hopefully at least one will play. We do not clash with any other British Congress of size and we therefore expect a good entry of several of the country's leading players. For anyone who has not played in the Congress before, County Hall is a magnificent venue offering probably the best playing conditions of any British Congress.

Our target is an overall entry of approx 425 so please let us have your entries as soon as possible and encourage your friends to enter also. 1986 is the anniversary of the greatest chess tournament of all time - 1936 Nottingham, when all of the world's leading players came to Nottingham. If we have any hopes of holding a similar prestigious grandmaster tournament in 1986 to celebrate this anniversary (I understand that the BCF has recently shown some interest) then we must clearly demonstrate that there will be strong local support. Clearly the best and possibly the only way of showing this is a good local entry for the 1985 Congress!

In the past we have found that not all club members have been aware of the Congress until the last minute and we would therefore urge all Club Secretaries and Team Captains to be active in support of the Congress by ensuring that all players know about the Congress, see an entry form, and are encouraged to play. ### U12 and U14 Championships

A 5 round Swiss tournament revealed that we had one outstanding Junior among the entrants - Matthew Kennedy of Nottingham High School who scored 5 successive wins. Second place with a score of  $3\frac{1}{2}/5$  was shared by Philip Bray (Nomads) and Robert Hallott (Kingswell School).

The Notts U/14 championship was held at the same venue 3 weeks later and again brought a disappointing entry of 8. An all-play-all tournament resulted in a win for the U/12 champion - Matthew Kennedy - with a score of 6/7 and one hopes that he will enter the U/16 championship in March to strive for what would be an unprecedented success.
