We do not clash with any other British Congress of size and we therefore expect a good entry of several of the country's leading players. For anyone who has not played in the Congress before, County Hall is a magnificent venue offering probably the best playing conditions of any British Congress.

Our target is an overall entry of approx 425 so please let us have your entries as soon as possible and encourage your friends to enter also. 1986 is the anniversary of the greatest chess tournament of all time - 1936 Nottingham, when all of the world's leading players came to Nottingham. If we have any hopes of holding a similar prestigious grandmaster tournament in 1986 to celebrate this anniversity (I understand that the BCF has recently shown some interest) then we must clearly demonstrate that there will be strong local support. Clearly the best and possibly the only way of showing this is a good local entry for the 1985 Congress!

In the past we have found that not all club members have been aware of the Congress until the last minute and we would therefore urge all Club Secretaries and Team Captains to be active in support of the Congress by ensuring that all players know about the Congress, see an entry form, and are encouraged to play.
