



### COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIP

Thirtyfive of the County's strongest players competed in the County Championship over the weekend of 29th November to 1st December at Rushcliffe Leisure Centre. The contest was extremely hard fought with only Paul Hare having won all his games after three rounds. After round four the previous years joint winners Mike Alcock and Steve Burke were both out of contention with 2½ points out of 4. Going into the final round Paul Hare was still in the lead with 4½ points from 5 games. Pairing for the final round was as follows:-

Both of these games were won by white leaving John Emms and Michael Barnes as joint winners. County Champion as a result of sum of opponents scores was John Emms mainly because Michael Barnes had taken a half point bye in round one. Prizes were presented by Richard Turton of Spicer and Pegler who had sponsored the event for the first time. Mr. Turton said "They were pleased to sponsor brains not brawn for a change as physical sport receives plenty of support."

REMEMBER NOTTINGHAM 1946?

Whilst it is true that this year sees the 50th anniversary of the great 1936 International Tournament in Nottingham, maybe a few readers will have forgotten, or even never knew that Nottingham also had the distinction of hosting the first post-war British Championship. That was back in the days of rationing, de-mob suits and homes fit for heroes. Maybe the day-to-day fabric of life was tough, but maybe also, people were different then...a world weary of war, and eager for friendship, co-operation, and community spirit.

It was also the time when Britain had no grandmasters of its own, anathema to today's infant prodigies reared on the exploits of Miles, Nunn, Keene and company. However, the field for the first post-war domestic Championship did include some fine players - Alexander, Golombek, Winter, Milner-Barry etc., and surely one would have expected the eventual winner to have come from this group. Instead, a young, and since his triumph, relatively unsung hero emerged in the shape of R.F.Combe. Not only did Combe beat Alexander in the very opening round, but he went on to win the title with the score of +7, =2, -2. Combe could possess a very incisive style when he felt inclined, and I commend the following victory gained with the black pieces against another combative player, A.R.B.Thomas, to your attention. The final attack is very pleasant; shortcomings in the annotations alas, will stem from me.

White's next few moves are directed against black's intended ...b5, so Combe directs operations against the King's wing.

Effective, but one of those moves that doesn't 'feel' right somehow. The next phase is bound up with black's renewed efforts to play ...b5. He achieves this, but Thomas uses his time to obtain a solid central preponderance.

It will not be easy for White to organise play against the dark squares around the Black King. His own dark-squared bishop has gone, his KB is somewhat restricted, and the b2 pawn is not in the best of health.

Much more combative than exd5, but Thomas still has hopes of organising an eventual e5 himself.

If black allowed Qf6, he would probably have to go in for a queen exchange. Combe avoids this possibility because he wants to play for the win.

White has achieved e5, but black's queen manoeuvres put the white position under pressure.

A Bolt from the blue! The white bishop must stand its ground. 29. Bh1 leaves the King uncomfortably placed, whilst 29. Be4? is a straightforward blunder.

Thomas again finds a combative reply, but black is prepared to sacrifice temporarily in order to break into the White camp.

29. Bxg2

30. Kxg2 Rxe4!

31. Rxe4 Qb3!!

The opened b-file at last yields dividends. Black's concluding attack is very impressive. The squares a2, d5, and f3 are all suddenly vulnerable.

32. Rxd4

White cannot hold the material, so he removes the unpleasant knight. Clearly, if 32. Ra3 Qxd5, followed by f5 wins quickly.

32. cxd4

33. Ra5 Rxd5

34. Rxa6

34. Rxd5 Qxd5+; 35. Kf2 etc., would leave white in a very passive position.

34. Qb7!

35. Ra3 Rb5 dis.+

36. Kh3

The tournament book gives 36. Kg1 Rxb2; 37. Ra8+ Qxa8; 38. Qxb2 Qe4 as winning for black. Obviously 37. Qxd4? allows mate at once. Mind you...

36. Rh5+

37. Kg4 f5 mate

Move 31 apart, Black's queen never left its first or second rank, but standing 'fianchettoed' as it does, seems to be directing operations from afar.

A very peaceful and pleasant year to chessplayers wherever they may be.

Following our defeat against Leicestershire, it was essential to win this match to have any realistic chance of qualifying for the later stages of the competition. Although the Notts. team was a little stronger than the one which faced Leics., a tight result was expected, in view of our narrow victory last season, and this turned out to be the case.

Unfortunately, I was unable to attend the match myself. However the results show the domination of Notts. upperboards, whilst the landslide on boards 14 - 18 left Derbys. leading by one point at adjudication, with four games still to be decided.

We are reasonably confident that all three adjudications will go our way, and we expect a similar decision in the dispute. This arose over a claim by the Derbys. player that he had a draw by repetition, and resulted in a prolonged argument involving several players. Fortunately, I haven't had any reports of the protagonists coming to blows, and the matter is now in the hands of the tournament controller.

To conclude, I would like to thank Tony Dempsey for stepping in at the last moment, for this match, and also confirm that Ron Clunies adjudicated game against Leics. was drawn, making the final score Leics I 15 - 5, Notts I. Hopefully we shall have an easier time in the New Year, when we play host to Lincolnshire and Northants, and provided Leics. defeat Derrbys. we should progress to the Knockout stages as we have done consistently in recent years.
