For the 1987/88 season the following clubs have each withdrawn one team: Sutton, Phoenix, Bulwell and Long Eaton. Promotion and relegation has been based on the usual three up/three down although some teams have declined promotion. The League Management Committee has also spared others relegation to enable it to introduce what it believes to be the best solution for the distribution of the teams throughout the League.

There will be four divisions next season, as before, but the fourth division will have ten teams who will play each other twice, home and away. This is because that division would have been too small otherwise. In its notice to clubs this year, the L.M.C. will

reserve the right to make more significant changes to the structure of the divisions. The precise details should either accompany this Bulletin or have been sent out before it. Set out below is the composition of the Divisions for the 1987/88 season.

#### LEAGUE SEASON 1986/87

I have included the final League tables for the season 1986/87 as this will be for many players the first time they will have seen them. A number were available at the A.G.M. in July.

It is clear from the tables who won what etc. but I would make a few general observations. Firstly I note the alarmingly high number of defaulted matches — 18 ! All the Univ. Students teams managed to default at least one match (one must applaud consistency) whilst Sutton V managed to default 4 games! The initial signs for this season are more promising. University Students seem better organised and Sutton have not entered a fifth team. I would hope tht all clubs will make every effort possible to fulfil all of their fixtures.

Secondly, I understand, although I do not have all the details, that a substantial number of matches last season were rearranged for one raeson or another. This I know caused Brian Hayward, the grading officer, difficulty in keeping a check on which games remained ungraded as result cards showed the date the match was played as opposed to when it should have been played. Whilst obviously Brian can and no doubt will liaise with the League Secretary with regard to rearranged fixtures, hopefully this season these will be kept to a minimum.

Finally I note that in Division 3 the Univ. Students 4 v
Nomads 3 match was not playued. Normally when this happens
one team is at fault or more at fault than the other and
therefore is defaulted. If both teams are equally to
blame, in the past it has been scored as a 0-0 double
default. On this occasion it was scored as a 2.5/2.5 draw;
this will hopefully not result in a dangerous precedent as
a way of avoiding relegation!

#### LOCAL NEWS

I have heard very little of this during the past few months but I do know of some fine Notts. players' performances in the recent British Championships held at Swansea. In the British Championship itself we had two players — Chris Dunworth (Oxclose) & John Emms (Univ. Students). Chris, I understand, had a poor start but finished strongly to finish in mid-table. John appeared up with the leaders for a number of rounds but finished just behind them.

Richard Burgess (West Bridgford & Leeds Univ) won one of the one week sections with 4.5/5 whilst John Swain (Gambit) scored 3.5/5 in a similar event during the second week of the Congress. If anyone has details of other players, please let me know.

#### GENERAL NEWS

English players have had great success in the Interzonal tournaments, the top three players in each tournament qualifying for the Candidates Tournament as part of the process of finding a challenger to the new World Champion (Kasparov v Karpov to meet later in Spain this year). Nigel Short & Jon Speelman became the first English players to reach the Candidates Tournament by finishing equal 1st in their Interzonal. John Nunn finished equal 3rd with Portisch (Hungary) in his Interzonal and now faces a best of six games play-off. Glenn Flear (ex Leicester) also played in this Tournament but finished below halfway. He did however beat John Nunn in one of the earlier rounds. Tony Miles started very poorly in his Interzonal and with the lack of detail in the press and on T.V., I presume he has not qualified for the Candidates.
