We welcomed a slightly reduced field of 169 players to the 35th Nottingham Rapidplay, held as usual at Nottingham High School, with a new layout. As per last year this was an ECF and FIDE rated event. Entries were much slower than usual compared to last year; but picked up in the last week.

We are extremely grateful and fortunate that the Nottinghamshire Chess Foundation provided the finance to pay for prizes for an Improvers' section. This attracted 44 players, many new to over-the-board chess. The challenge to the Nottinghamshire chess community is to maintain this interest.
